Let the life of Jesus Christ, then, be our first consideration... Whoever desires to understand and take delight in the words of Christ must strive to conform his whole life to Him [2]."

Plato identified three distinct elements of the soul or psyche, that make up who we are and are responsible for our behaviour. The theory attempts to explain why we do what we do. We can use this awareness to make better life decisions and improve our behaviour.
